**CALL TO ORDER**

USARC Partnership Council Members present were Mr. Michael McDonnell, Mr. William Schimek, Mr. John Esposito, Mr. Donald Stumpff Jr., Mr. Billy Thomas, Mr. Tony Cox, Mr. Glen Rodman Jr., and Mr. Ken Williamson. Absent were Mr. Henry Pierce Sr., and Mr. Raymond Helmick.

Mr. McDonnell called the meeting to order.

Minutes of previous meeting were reviewed and approved.

**OLD BUSINESS**

***Tasker 0600-03, Requirement to sign a new Condition of Employment (COE) upon promotion involving a change in status from TPU support to AMSA/ECS or visa versa.*** Mr. Williamson indicated there was no news to report. The USARC SJA is monitoring this action. ***The council agreed to close this action.***

***Federal Employee Student Loan Repayment Program.*** Per Mr. Williamson, working on getting into the 05 POM. ***This tasker is closed; however, updates will be provided as they become available.***

***Tasker 0300-01, PPP registration.*** Mr. Williamson reported no change. ***This tasker remains open.***

***RIF Procedures involving NDSTs.*** Mr. Williamson stated nothing further, still awaiting TJAG opinion. ***This issue is open and ongoing.***

***Training of UAs/UATs.*** Council could not reach consensus. ***The council agreed to close this action.***

***BASEOPS reorganization.*** The council agreed this is now Transformation of Installation Management (TIM). ***The council agreed to close this action.***

***Centralization of Resumix.*** Mr. Thomas provided an update indicating that the action will be completed August 8, 2002. ***The council agreed to close this action.***

***Other issues.*** An issue was raised regarding a memorandum sent out from Mr. Gray to the RSCs 6-months ago which asked for a copy of orders for all NDSTs. It dealt with the proposed removal within 30 days. ***Mr. Thomas indicated Mr. Gray has this action and he would check into this.***

### **NEW BUSINESS**

***Congressional Update.*** Mr. Esposito provided an update on pending legislation for the USAR and Federal Employees.

***AR-140-315.*** Council discussed and determined there was no consensus to make it an issue for the council. ***This issue is closed.***

***Elimination of GS-1106 series from the AT&LW.*** The council agreed this is not a major issue and will be dealt with at the local level. ***This issue is closed.***

***Transformation of Installation Management (TIM).*** Mr. Williamson indicated DA implementation plan is out. No final decision to TIM below USARC HQ. Access the Army web site and read all about it. Site is at [www.HQDA.army.mil/acsim](http://www.HQDA.army.mil/acsim) and look for TIM. ***This issue remains open.***

***How to back-fill positions currently vacant due to an AGR tour but not resigning as a MT.*** Discussed by council. Approval on a case by case basis. Will accommodate as can. Consideration is given based on funds availability. ***The council agreed to close this issue.***

***Calculating authorizations both DAC and MTs.*** This is covered in the issue below and ***is closed.***

***Rules on changing DAC authorizations to MTs.*** Changes are normally submitted on a 2028 through the chain of command. Deviations can be done to meet the necessity of the organization. ***The council agreed to close this issue.***

***Definitive policy on computer use both official and personal use.*** Current USARC policy still in effect; however, the current policy is being revised. Mr. Thomas will check on status. ***This issue remains open.***

***USARC implementation instructions for Telework.*** Policy out to field 17 Jun 02. ***This issue is closed.***

### **CLOSING REMARKS**

Mr. Rodman was elected Council Chair.

The next Partnership Council meeting date was set for Oct 9-10, 2002 at an off site location within Atlanta, GA, to be determined.
